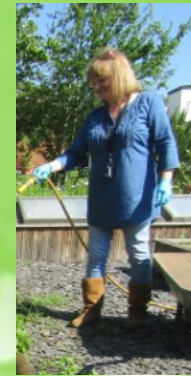


Would you like to join our parent / helper garden club and help with our good work under the guidance of The Woodland Trust?
