Wanderers Sports Association Swimming Gala

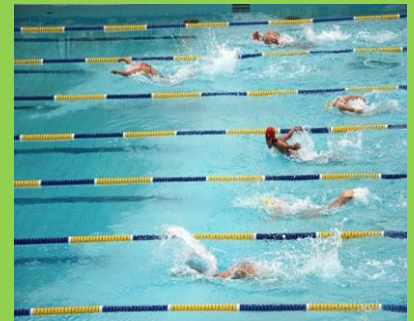
