STAR OF THE WEEK

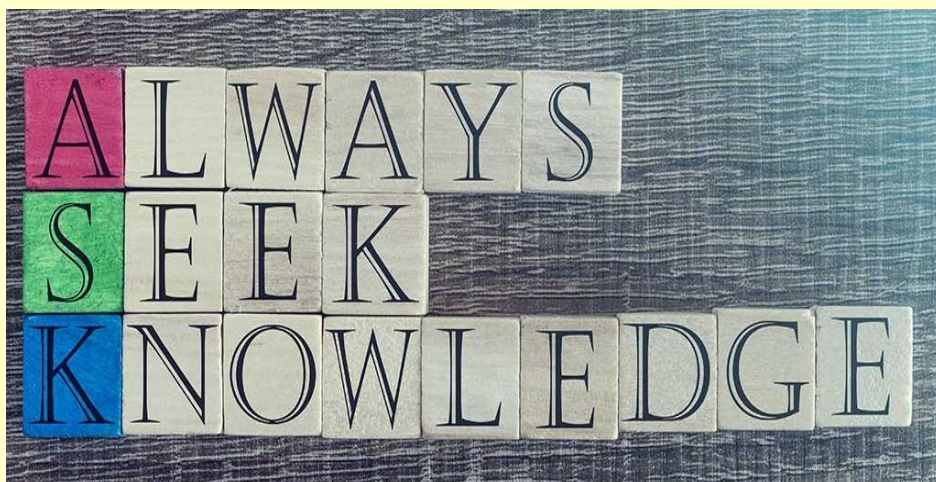
