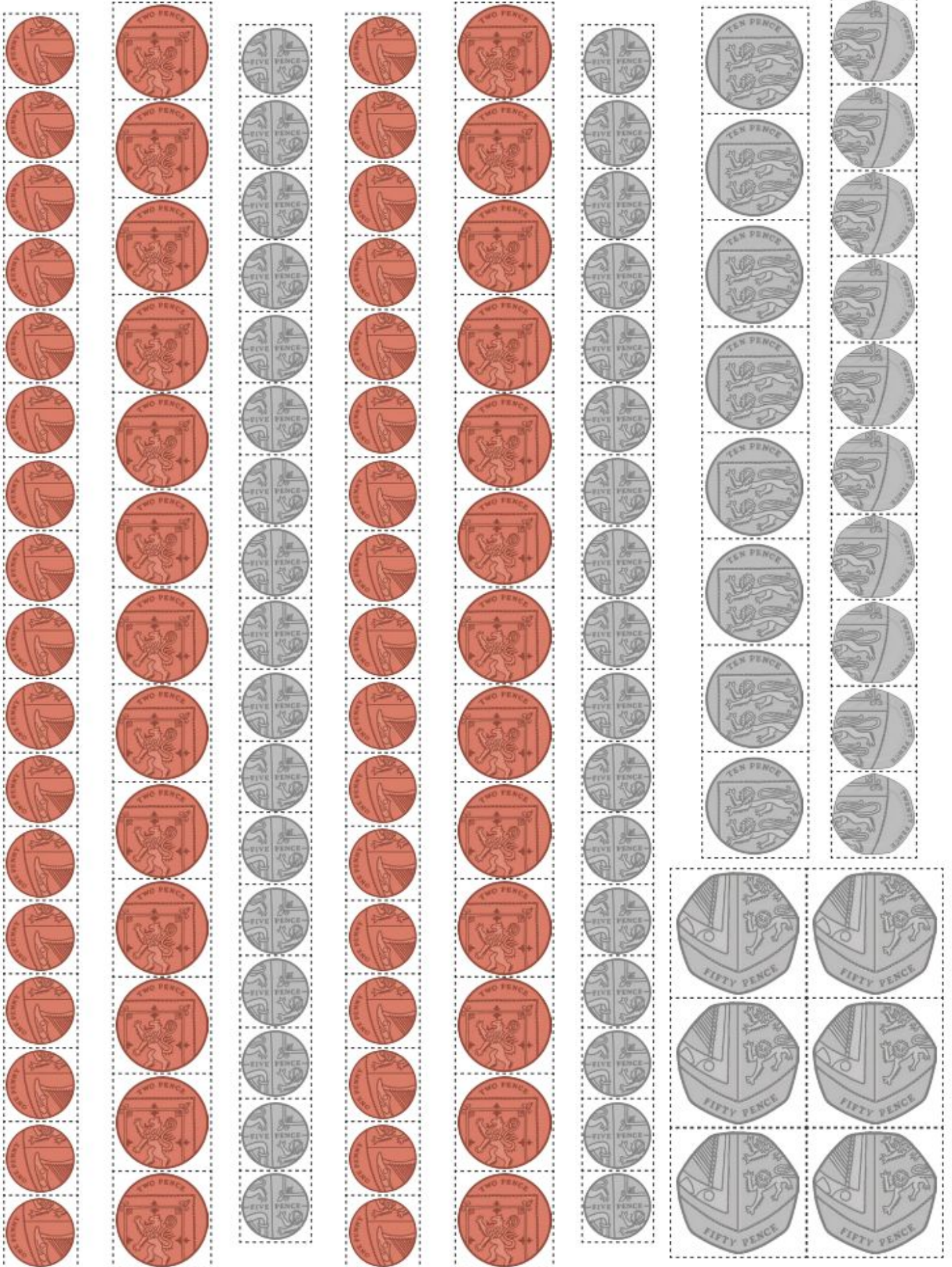

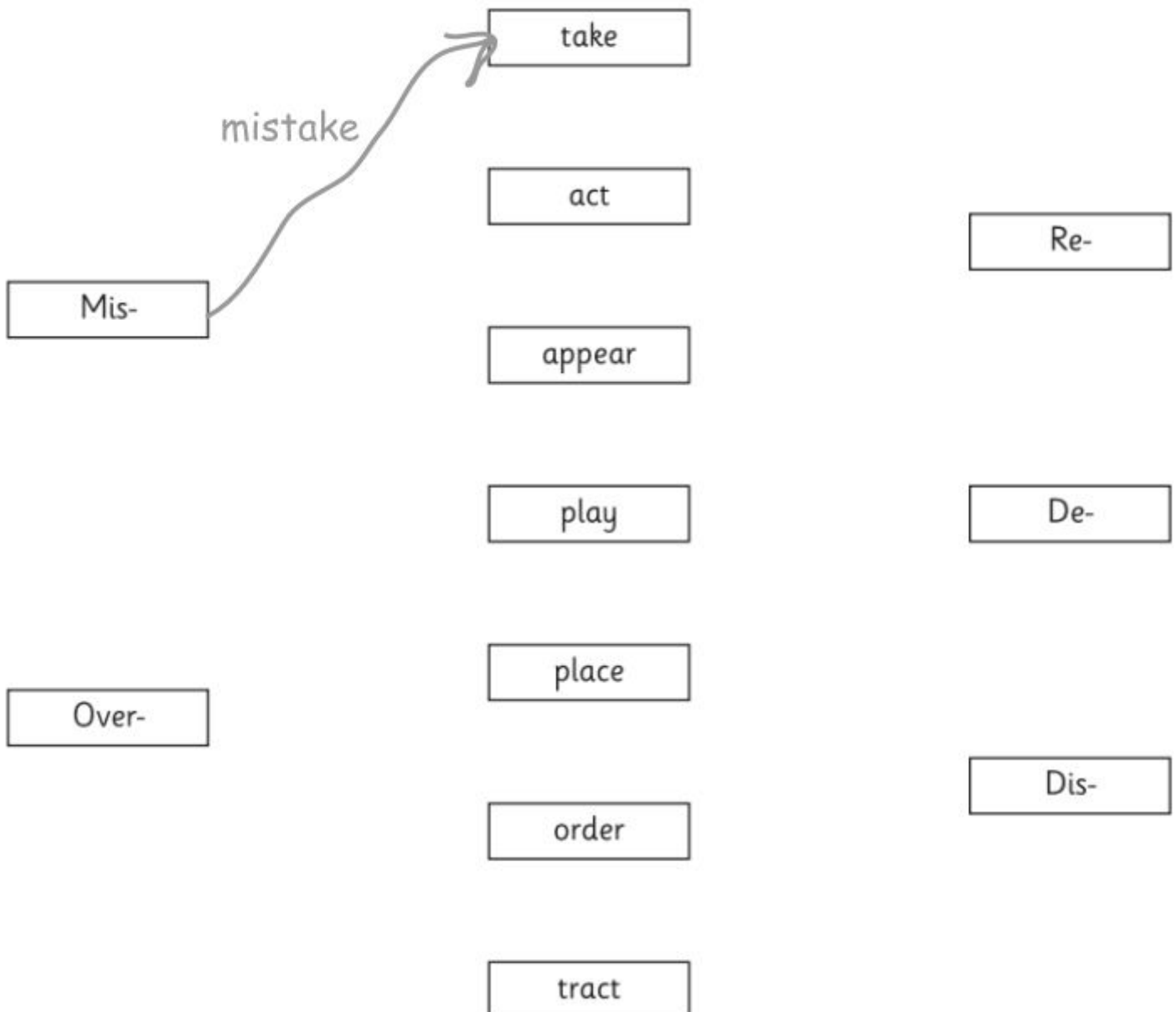

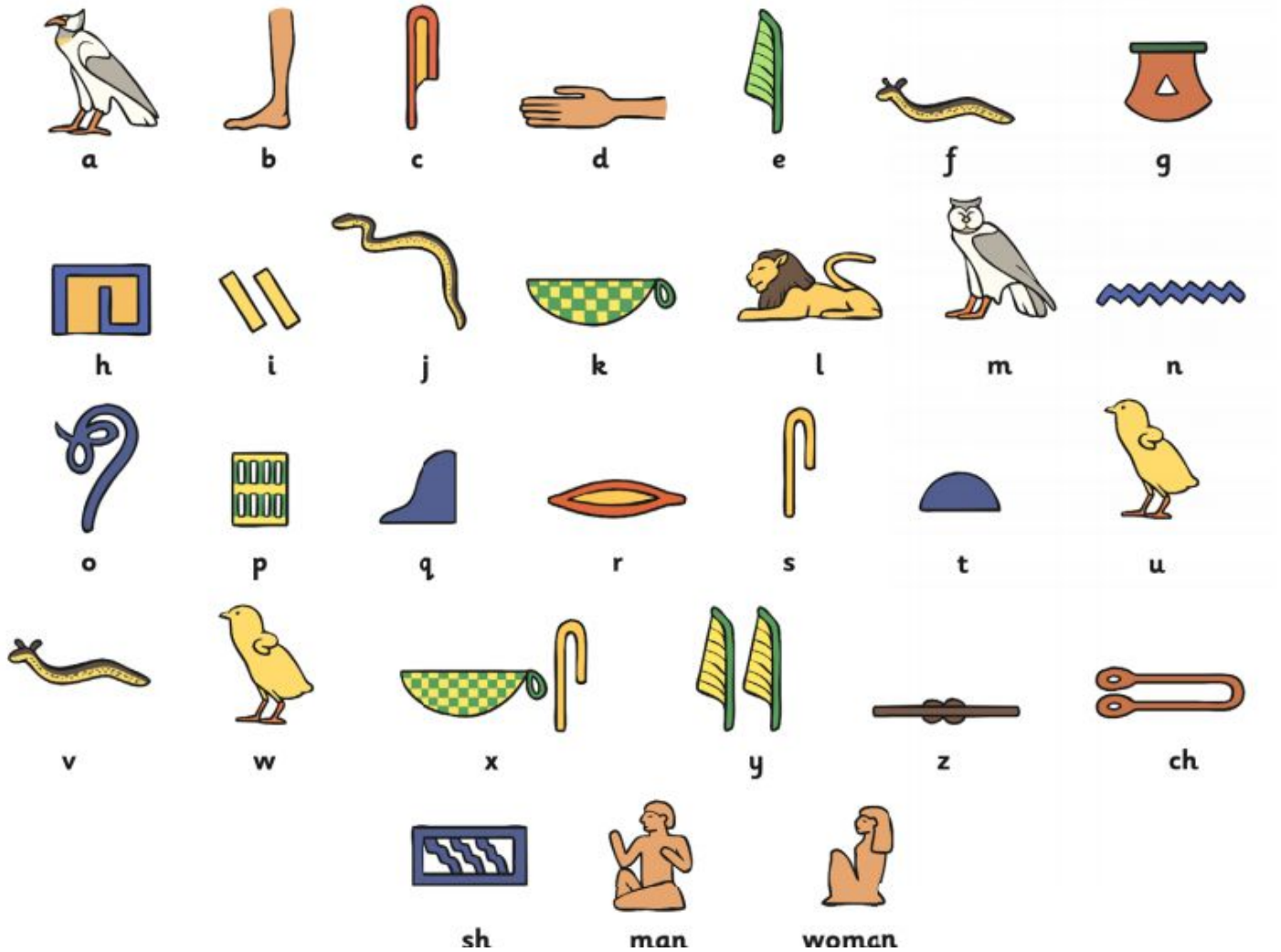

Can you draw lines from each **prefix** on the **left** and **right** to a middle word; together they will make a word. (You may need a dictionary... or Google!)

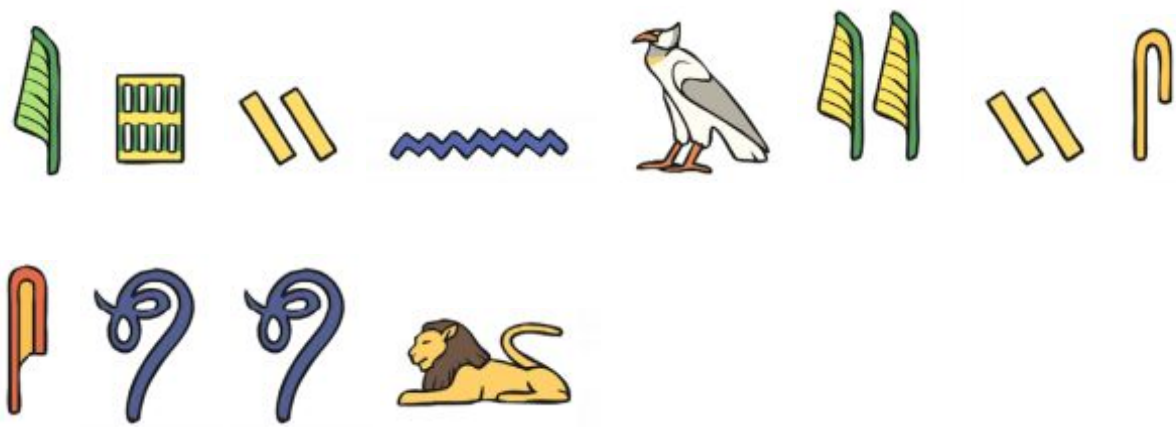


History
