

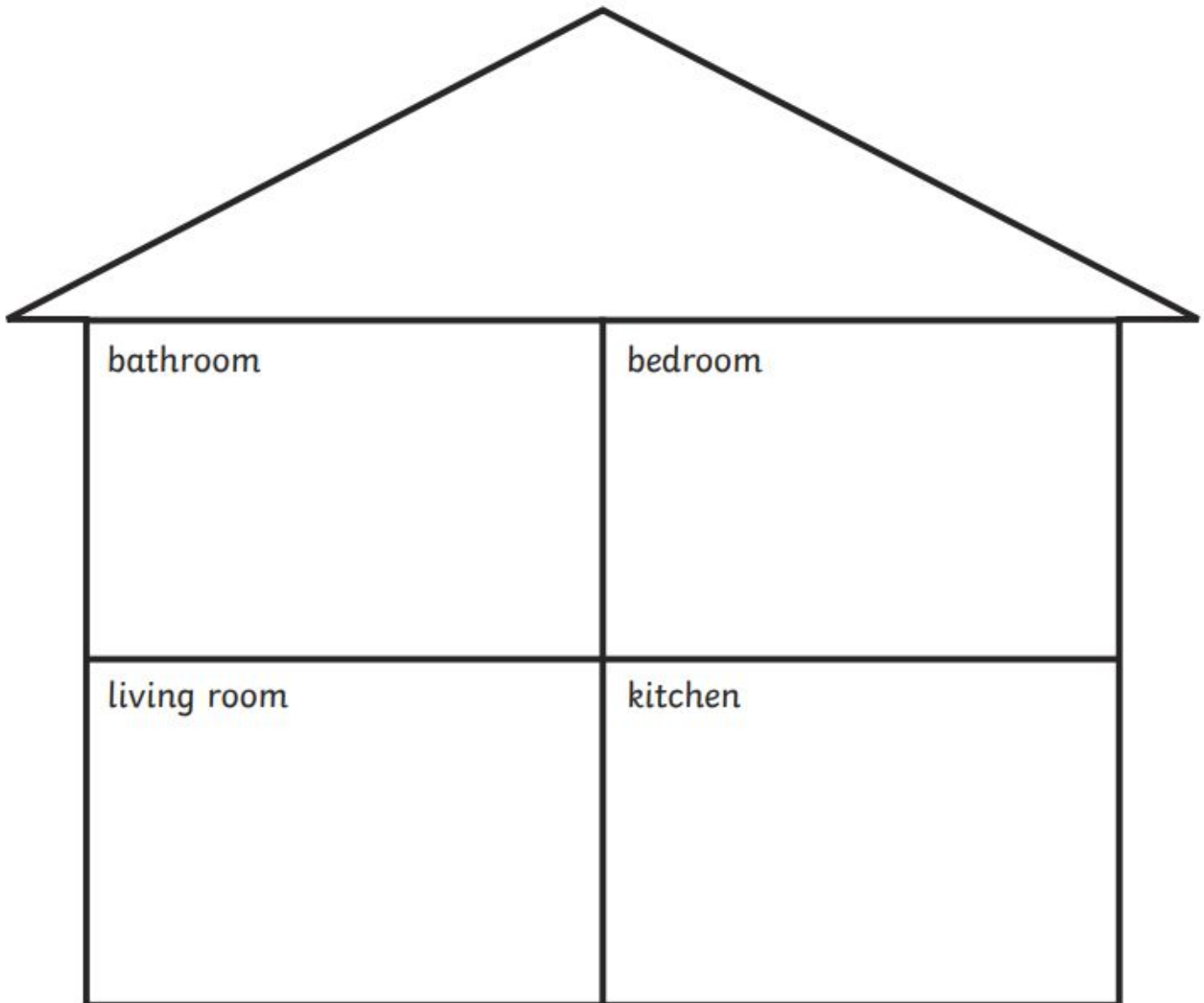

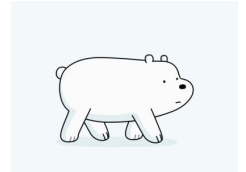
Next week is **Climate Week**, when people from around the world think about ways to help the Earth.

There are \_\_\_\_\_ many people in here.



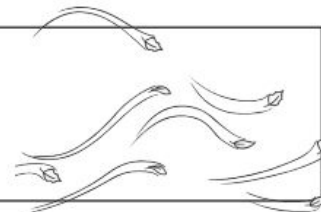
### New or knew?

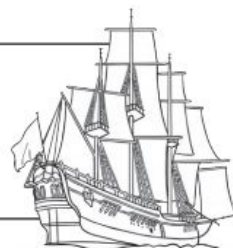

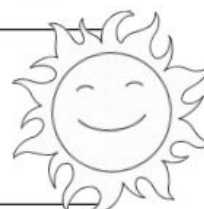
### Sea or see?

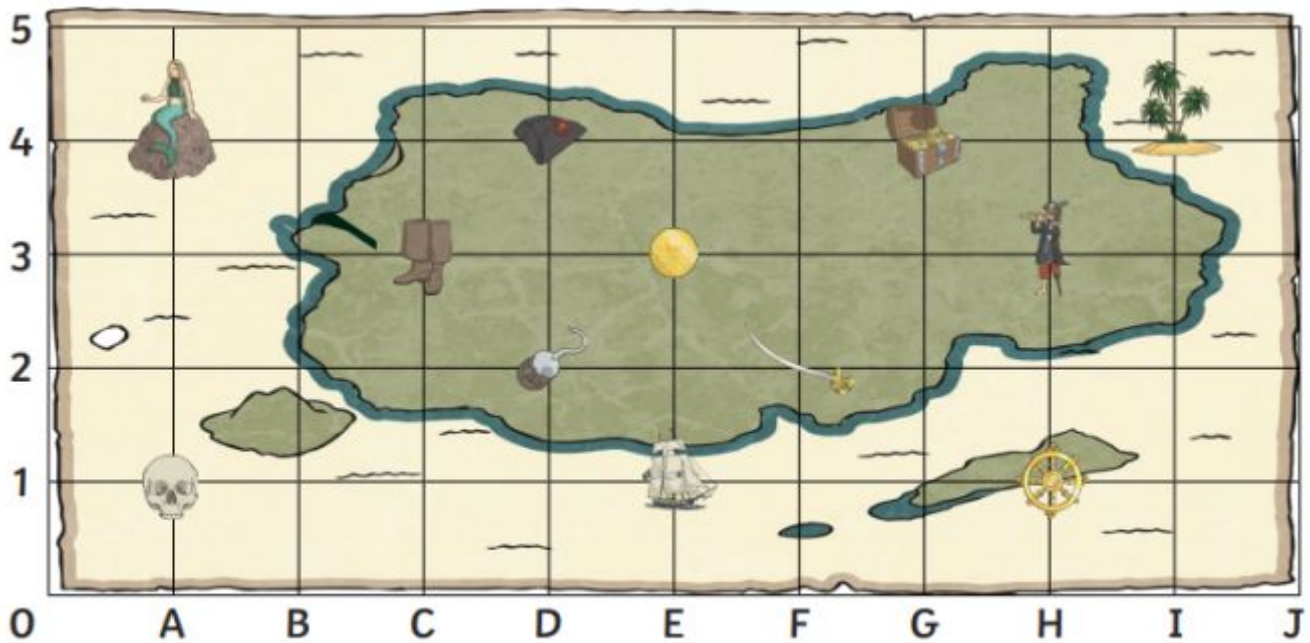

**Maths, secondary**

A **coordinate** is two letters or numbers which tells you where something is on a map or grid.
